The ideal candidate will have a strong record of accomplishment as a leader, a distinctive background in instruction, experience supporting English language learners, outstanding communication skills, a collaborative philosophy, and the ability to involve all stakeholders in the process of growth and change. The next Superintendent of District 59 will inherit a talented staff, a highly supportive Board of Education and a community willing to work together to achieve excellence for its children.

The District

Community Consolidated School District 59 is a Pre-K through 8th grade school district located in the desirable northwest suburbs of Chicago. The district encompasses portions of Elk Grove Village, Arlington Heights, Des Plaines, Mount Prospect and unincorporated Cook County. The student body represents a cultural richness and diversity that complement the district's instructional programs.

The district's 5,700 students are served in 15 schools, including one Early Childhood Center, 11 elementary and 3 middle schools. 1,080 teachers and instructional staff provide their educational expertise and caring attention to the students. District highlights include:

- Strengthened curriculum and instructional practices districtwide, resulting in measurable academic growth across all student groups
- Completed significant facility upgrades to improve the safety and learning environments, and initiated a long-range facilities planning process to guide future investments
- Enhanced programming to support our large population of diverse English language learners including the district's dual language programs in Spanish and Polish, promoting bilingualism, biliteracy, and cultural competency
- Signed a new 4-year CBA with both certified and support staff groups
- Expanded Early Childhood programming to increase enrollment and services for youngest learners

- Increased the capacity of the Community Outreach Specialist team, strengthening family engagement and connecting more families with critical resources

The Communities

District 59 is approximately 32 miles northwest of downtown Chicago in the busy O'Hare Airport corridor. In addition to its proximity to Chicago and all it has to offer, the CCSD59 communities offer a wide array of cultural activities, parks, shopping, and entertainment. While District 59 comprises portions of four northwest suburban communities, the school district is a true hub for the area. Some highlights from the four communities include:

- Elk Grove Village was named the 2022 and 2024 recipient of the Municipality of the Year Award from Illinois RE Journals Magazine
- Arlington Heights showcases a vibrant downtown area that includes entertainment, restaurants, housing and is the potential future home of the Chicago Bears.
- Des Plaines is home to the Rivers Casino and the newly restored and historic Des Plaines Theater
- Mount Prospect boasts a newly renovated downtown area, as well as 400 acres of parks and recreation facilities for residents to enjoy
